SUPPLY LIST

K2

- 6x9 steno notebook - for notes to and from the teachers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 bottle of foaming hand sanitizer (not hand soap)
- 1 refillable water bottle (sent home daily)
- 2 complete changes of clothes in gallon-sized Ziploc bags (to be kept at school)
- 1 package baby wipes
- 1 box 8 count large Crayola crayons
- 1 pack Construction Paper

K3

- 6x9 steno notebook - for notes to and from the teachers
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of Clorox Wipes
- 1 refillable water bottle (sent home daily)
- 1 complete change of clothes in gallon-sized Ziploc bag (to be kept in their backpack)
- 1 package baby wipes
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 box 24 count Crayola crayons
- 1 box 8 count large Crayola crayons

For potty-training two and three-year olds

- 2 packages of wipes
- Pull-Ups with Velcro

K4

- 6x9 steno notebook - for notes to and from the teachers
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 container of Clorox Wipes
- 1 refillable water bottle (sent home daily)
- 1 complete change of clothes in gallon-sized Ziploc bag (to be kept in their backpack)
- 1 oversized, button down, collared shirt (to be used as a painting smock)
- 1 package baby wipes
- 1 vinyl folder
- 2 boxes of Crayola crayons (16 or 24 count)
- 1 box of gallon-sized Ziploc bags

For children staying after 12:00 (noon)

- KinderMat nap mat - red/blue and red/gray only; no roll-up or oversized mats
- Pillow and blanket small enough to stay in the backpack

Accidents can happen unexpectedly, even if your child is fully potty-trained. Should your child have an accident, soiled clothing will be sent home and must be replaced by the next school day. Extra clothing must also be updated occasionally to ensure that the items fit properly and are appropriate for the season's weather.

We do ask that parents be careful in selecting themed backpacks and lunch boxes, as some may be inappropriate for preschool - rock stars and some cartoon characters (SpongeBob, The Dark Knight, Hulk, etc.).

Please do not purchase backpacks that are shaped like suitcases, or those that contain wheels.

Naptime mats must be thrown away if torn or otherwise damaged, as they cannot be properly sanitized. Parents are strongly encouraged to purchase an extra mat to keep at home as a replacement, as these mats are not often carried year-round in stores.

Parents will be notified through the weekly *Lil' Conqueror's Corner* newsletter if additional supplies are needed throughout the year.
